NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 31st March, 2011

No. 2-46/2010-MAEF.—In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule X of the Rules and Regulations and Para 3 of the Memorandum of Association of Maulana Azad Education Foundation (MAEF), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules and regulation, the method of recruitment to various posts in the MAEF, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the MAEF (Group 'A, B, C and D' Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial Posts) Recruitment Rules.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and Pay Band and Grade Pay.—The number of said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications.—The method of recruitment to the post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

Intitial Constitution.—(1) The personnel holding the posts on regular basis before the commencement of these rules, shall be deemed to have been appointed in accordance with the provisions of these rules.

(2) The regular continuous service of personnel mentioned the sub-rule (1) prior to the posts at the initial constitution shall count for the purpose of probation period qualifying service for promotion, confirmation and pension in the service.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who, has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Governing Body is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the approval of the Central Government relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age-limits and other concessions required to be provided for the special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
